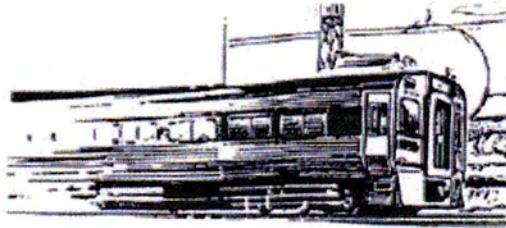

All times shown are Chicago time

Leave Millennium/Randolph Street Station (under Millennium Park) in downtown Chicago (Randolph Street and Michigan Avenue) at 8:40 a.m. and return at 7:15 p.m. (Be there by 8:10 a.m. for check-in)

Arrive Hudson Lake at 11:00 A.M.

Buffet will be serving from approximately 12:00 noon until 1:30 p.m.

Dennis Scott will perform at the organ for your dining and dancing pleasure

Concert and dancing with the band will be from 12:30 to 3:00 p.m.

Movie starts at approximately 3:00

Train leaves Hudson Lake at 5:05 p.m.

Returns to Randolph Street Station at 7:15 p.m.
